B. Cyclonic Circulation:

- ❖ A Western Disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation over north Pakistan & neighborhood in lower tropospheric level persists.
- ❖ Another Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 60°E to the north of Lat. 30°N persists.
- ❖ Subtropical westerly Jet Stream with core winds of the order upto 120 knots at 12.6 km above mean sea level prevails over Northwest India.
- ❖ An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over south Tamil Nadu and neighborhood in the lower tropospheric level.
- ❖ A fresh feeble Western Disturbance is likely to affect Western Himalayan region from the night of 17th December 2025.

Under the influence of these systems, the following weather is likely:

- ❖ Light rainfall/snowfall at few/isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan, Muzaffarabad on 15th December & during 18th -21st December and over Himachal Pradesh on 15th December & during 20th & 21st December and Uttarakhand on 15th December and 21st December.
- ❖ Thunderstorm and lightning very likely at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 16th December & 17th December with gusty winds with speed reaching upto 30-40 kmph very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 15th December - 18th December.

Temperature Conditions during past 24 hours till 0830 hours IST of today:

- ❖ Minimum temperatures were below 5°C at many places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh in the range of 5°-10°C at many places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Odisha and Vidarbha; over few places over Assam & Meghalaya, Telangana and Chhattisgarh; over isolated places over Tamil Nadu. The lowest minimum temperature of 4.8 °C is reported at Bathinda (Punjab) over the plains of India.
- ❖ Minimum Temperatures were markedly below normal ($\leq -5.1^{\circ}\text{C}$) at few places Karnataka, at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Karaikal and Telangana appreciably below normal (-5.0°C to -3.1°C) at few places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Marathawada, Odisha and at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe and Assam and Meghalaya below normal (-1.6°C to -3.0°C) at few places over Madhya Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh West Bengal, Sikkim, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Yanam; at isolated places over Haryana Chandigarh, Delhi, East Rajasthan and Bihar.

- ❖ Minimum Temperatures show rising tendency during past 24 hours by 1-3°C at many over Himachal Pradesh & Gujarat Region; isolated places over Telangana, Vidarbha, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Assam and Gangetic West Bengal; falling tendency by 1-2°C over some parts of Tamil Nadu and South Interior Karnataka, at isolated places over Haryana, North Madhya Pradesh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Yanam.

Forecast of minimum temperatures:

- ❖ Gradual fall in minimum temperature likely by about 2°C over Northwest India during next 2 days and thereafter gradual rise by about 2-3°C during subsequent 4 days.
- ❖ No significant change in minimum temperature very likely over Gujarat state during next 42 days and thereafter rise by 2-3°C during subsequent 3 days.
- ❖ No significant change in minimum temperature over Maharashtra as well as Central, East and North east part of India during next 7 days.

Dense Fog & Cold wave Warnings:

- ❖ Dense fog conditions very likely to prevail during early hours/morning hours in isolated pockets of Northeast India during 16th -20th December, Himachal Pradesh during 16th -18th December, Punjab, Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi on 16th & 17th December.
- ❖ Dense fog conditions very likely to prevail during early hours/morning hours in isolated pockets of Uttar Pradesh on 16th & 17th December and Madhya Pradesh during 16th -18th December with very dense fog over Uttar Pradesh on 16th December and Madhya Pradesh on 16th & 17th December.

Fisherman Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into the following areas during 15th December to 20th December:

- ❖ **Bay of Bengal:** Over Gulf of Mannar (Tamil Nadu, Kerala) and adjoining Comorin area during 15th to 19th December.

Gas leakage incident in district Dhanbad (Jharkhand)

As intimated by DC Dhanbad and DDMO, on 03.12.2025 at around 1100 hrs, an incident of gas leakage due to underground mine fire at Rajpoot Basti u/PS Kenduadih, District Dhanbad came into notice of district administration. Relief and rescue operations are being carried out by mining rescue teams (BCCL) and the local administration.
